- classroom rules

- teaching philosophy
- lesson plans
- links outside of the institution
- online articles or newsletters
- classroom photo album
- class news/teacher blogs
- lunch menus
- samples of flashcards
- personal links
- teacher's family information

What Parents Label as Essential, But Teachers Don't:

- online practice tests
- academic advising information
- administration and school board news
- teacher resume
